For this project, Thomas R Tavella, FASLA served as the Project Manager and Landscape Architect who worked in conjunction with Hartford-based architectural firm, JCJ Architecture, and internationally-renowned, HOK Sport + Venue + Event, to develop the football complex at the University of Connecticut Storrs Campus. The complex is the on-campus home of UConn's football program and houses coaches' offices, team meeting rooms, locker rooms, and other football-related facilities. As a state-of-the-art indoor practice facility incorporating 'green building' techniques, the complex was the first NCAA facility to achieve a LEED Silver rating. Tavella's design incorporated numerous rain gardens and biofiltration swales to treat stormwater on-site.
